<p>ADDITIONAL INFORMATION</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> If the medication order states "on hand," please do not send order to pharmacy. Some insurance plans cover the medication Medicare Part B and D benefits. For travel vaccines call MultiCare Covington Family Medicine at 253-372-7100, Passport Health at 206-414-2709, or UW Medicine at 206-685-1011 We cannot provide TDAP MMR or Shingrix to Medicare patients We cannot provide Quantiferon TB tests or immune titers, but blood can be drawn in our lab with a signed order
