COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This half day course is designed to help parents gain a better understanding of sensory integration and how it affects their child's daily life. Parents will learn basic therapeutic approaches that are used to treat sensory integration dysfunction, thereby improving their child's participation in daily life activities. These intervention techniques involve parent and child coaching, direct one to one intervention, home programming and parent self study.
