

FOR THE SAFETY OF OUR PATIENTS, VISITORS AND STAFF AND TO SLOW THE SPREAD OF COVID-19, VISITOR SCREENING AND RESTRICTIONS ARE IN EFFECT:

- All visitors, patients and caregivers will be screened for symptoms.
- You may not enter the facility if you have symptoms, unless you are a patient.
- Everyone is required to wear a face mask , unless you have a qualifying health condition. You will be provided with a mask if you arrive without one.
- Please stay 6 feet away from others whenever possible.

VISITOR RESTRICTIONS

- Visiting hours will be restricted to 8 a.m. – 8 p.m.
- Only one caregiver or support person is allowed for each patient per day (or the same two visitors per day if patients are 17 or under).
- No visitors under the age of 17 will be allowed unless they are patients.
- Visitors will be issued a wristband for the day to help identify them to our staff.
- No visitors will be allowed for patients with suspected or confirmed cases of COVID-19.
- Only one caregiver or support person will be allowed to accompany patients arriving for surgery or procedures (or two if patients are 17 or under).
- No visitors will be allowed to enter through the Emergency Department unless you are accompanying an emergency patient.
- If you are not at the hospital to receive care or to visit a patient, you will not be allowed to enter (except vendors).

VISITORS WITH OUTPATIENT APPOINTMENTS IN HOSPITAL FACILITIES

- Patients with appointments in outpatient areas or clinics within the hospital will also be screened.
- Only one caregiver or support person will be allowed to accompany patients with outpatient appointments.
