



Covid-19 Convalescent Plasma (CCP) Ordering Process for Providers

Effective: 08/29/20

Effective August 29th, Covid-19 Convalescent Plasma (CCP) will be available at MultiCare facilities under Emergency Use Authorization (EUA). The supply of CCP may be limited at times and should be prioritized for use in those most likely to benefit based on the available evidence to date.

MHS CCP Criteria
Inclusions
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Patient is hospitalized • COVID-19 test positive, or high clinical suspicion of infection with pending test • Patient has severe or immediately life-threatening COVID-19 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Severe disease is defined as <u>one or more</u> of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ shortness of breath (dyspnea) ○ respiratory frequency ≥ 30/min ○ blood oxygen saturation $\leq 93\%$ ○ partial pressure of arterial oxygen to fraction of inspired oxygen ratio < 300 ○ lung infiltrates $> 50\%$ within 24 to 48 hours ▪ Life-threatening disease is defined as <u>one or more</u> of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ respiratory failure ○ septic shock ○ multiple organ dysfunction or failure
Exclusions
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • History of severe allergic reactions or anaphylaxis to plasma transfusion

CCP Ordering Process:

1. Open a progress note and use the SmartPhrase **.CCPEUA** to document consent, eligibility criteria, and patient receipt of “Fact Sheet for Patients and Parents/Caregivers.”
2. Ensure routine Blood Product Consent/Refusal form is completed.
3. Verify a blood type is on file. If not, please order Blood Type (BT) as an individual or add-on lab.
4. Order CCP in Blood Products Order Set 425 (see page 2).
 - Transfusion Services/Patient Blood Management will double check for eligibility note before issuing CCP
5. Investigate any transfusion reaction through regular MHS processes.
