

# MultiCare Signage Placement Guidelines

## Overview

- The purpose of this guideline is to establish a uniform interior system of signage types and placement throughout MHS Hospitals, Clinics and Office Buildings.
- Current interior signage is a blend of multiple styles, materials, colors, sizes and installation practices. The intent of this guideline is to have a single system and/or philosophy will be adopted to implement at each of the facilities

### Installation Support

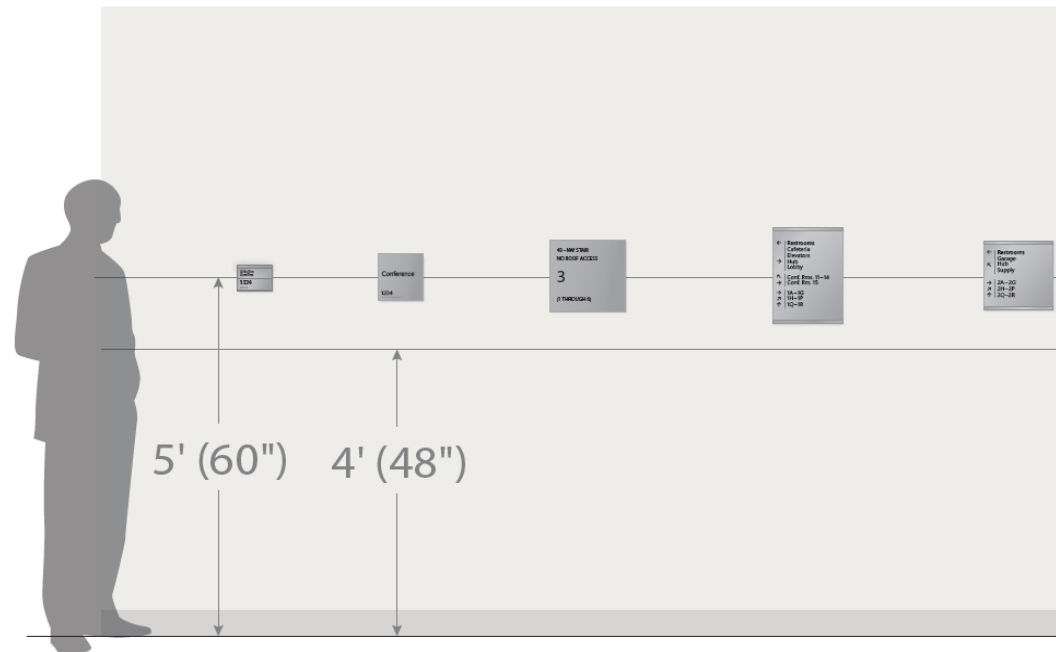

- Incorrect or improperly installed signage should be reported to Facilities or Property Management

# MultiCare Signage Placement Guidelines

## Installation, Support and Product Types

### Wall Signage - Mounting Height

- Signs should be hung so that the center of the is 5'-0" (60") above the floor.



**Note:** Tactile characters shall be 48" minimum above floor and 60" inches maximum above floor per ICC/ANSI 17771.1 730.0

# MultiCare Signage Placement Guidelines

## Installation, Support and Product Types

### Floor Signage – Placement

- Floor signs must be placed 6 feet apart and follow direction or flow of traffic for lobbies, waiting and reception areas



# MultiCare Signage Placement Guideline

Floor Signage – vinyl decals, design selection can be made from vendor inventory and MHS designs

## Wall

- Wall – signage installation must be made with 3m or Scotch command strips designed for interior use and remove without wall damage
  - Product Code #17523

## Carpet

- Carpet – 3.4mil vinyl decal designed to work with a variety of carpet types. Has a lifespan of 3-6moths based on foot traffic and is available with both adhesive applied or w/out.

## Flooring(hardwood, tile, laminate, concrete)

- Flooring – 9mil vinyl decal designed to work on all hard surface flooring. Has a lifespan of up to 5 years based on foot traffic and available with both adhesive applied or w/out.

**Note:** Please refrain from using unapproved products like tapes (blue tape, double sticky tape, duct tape, and glues/adhesives as these can damage wall coverings, floors and carpets. Improper floor installations can present a trip hazards
